It also has a single-speed transmission, a low seat height, a wide front apron that helps provide weather protection and roomy floorboards. • The next step up in scooters is the Riva Jog, a

slightly more powerful scooter with a 50cc-class two-stroke engine. Upgrades include a variable ratio V-Belt transmission-just twist the throttle and gobecause the Jog transmission automatically adjusts for speed and throttle setting. It even has an enclosed, no-maintenance drive system for clean, quiet operation. In addition to electric starting, the Jog also has an automatic choke-so even if you're late for school, you can't blame the Jog, because it's always ready to go. Rugged, but still friendly, Jog has a large seat and a comfortable floorboard. There's even a rear luggage rack and a glove box. • Want the biggest scooter in the Riva line-up? Get a Riva 125, the commuter scooter that's capable of maintaining freeway speeds or taking a passenger out for a ride. The Riva 125 has bottom link front suspension and dual rear shocks to keep the ride smooth. Its four-stroke engine keeps cool with an electric cooling fan, located inside enclosed body panels so your ride is nice and quiet. Other cool touches on the Riva 125 are dual helmet locks, a cargo rack, and a locking storage bin. . The Razz, Jog and Riva 125. They're inexpensive to buy, fun to use, and when it comes to daily fuel costs, they're about as close as you can get to a free ride.
